Q: I already applied for a Mail-in Ballot. What should I do with it?

A: After you receive your mail-in ballot, bring it un-opened to your early voting location, turn it in, then vote In-Person.

Q: I don't feel comfortable going inside a polling place.

A: You can vote "CURBSIDE." If you are 65 or older, or have a physical disability, you may vote without leaving your vehicle.

Q: I hear the lines are very long. I don't have time to wait.

A: Now that Satellite voting offices have opened in most VA counties, wait times are shorter. [[Find satellites in your area](#)]
